



Frequently Asked Questions

1. Is there a fundraising requirement? Yes. You must raise a minimum of \$5,000 to participate in the week long "700 Miles to Hope". There are no exceptions. In the event that you do not meet the minimum fundraising requirement by the deadline 12/31/17, The Matthew and Andrew Akin Foundation has the authority to and will charge your credit card for the remaining balance. The registration fee is non-refundable, nontransferable and will count towards your fundraising goal.

2. What is the cost to register? \$150 and it must be paid at the time of registration.

3. What is the registration deadline? Registration will be available May 1, 2017. Riders will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis. The first twenty riders to pay their \$150 deposit will be guaranteed a spot.

4. Is there a training schedule? Yes, is available via website.

5. What is the minimum age to ride? 18

6. Is there a health insurance requirement to participate? You will be required to provide a copy of your state issued I.D and valid health insurance card. This will need to be included with your registration form.

7. What is provided for me on the ride?

- * 3 cycling kits
- * professional Sag support
- * double-occupancy hotel rooms (beginning 9/16-9/22)
- * breakfast & lunch every day, 3 dinners
- * hydration & food at all rest stops
- * '700 Miles to Hope' t-shirt

8. What am I expected to pay for on the ride?

- * bike, helmet, shoes, glasses, gear for bicycle
- * transportation down to Jackson, Mississippi where ride begins & once we finish the ride at CCHMC, transportation back home
- * 4 dinners
- * any other misc. incidentals
